Sermon Notes SWITCH

From Asking to Hearing 1 John 5:14-15; James 4:3; Jeremiah 29:12-13

The first thing we need to do to hear from God is
After RESTING in Him through reading His Word then I make a!
Where I focus my attention determines my direction.
¹⁴ And we are confident that he hears us whenever we ask for anything that pleases him. ¹⁵ And since we know he hears us when we make our requests, we also know that he will give us what we ask for (1 John 5:14-15, NLT).
³ And even when you ask, you don't get it because your motives are all wrong—you want only what will give you pleasure (James 4:3, NLT).
We do that by not only RESTing, then making a REQUEST. Lastly, we must finally his voice.
"Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and you will find me when you seek me with all of your heart" (Jeremiah 29:12-

13, NIV).
